A RESOLUTION RELATING TO AN AGREEMENT WITH BERWICK
BOROUGH TO PERMIT BRIAR CREEK BOROUGH RESIDENTS TO
RECYCLE AT BERWICK'S RECYCLING CENTER

BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved by the Borough Council of Briar Creek
Borough that it is in the best interests and for the general welfare of the citizens and residents of
Briar Creek Borough to cooperate with Berwick Borough to permit access to Berwick's
Recycling Center for the purpose of recycling by Briar Creek Borough residents; and Briar Creek
Borough shall enter into a written Agreement with Berwick Borough for the purpose of outlining
the understanding between the two municipalities, which Agreement shall be in the same form
and substance as the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and titled "Recycling Agreement",
and Briar Creek Borough and Berwick Borough shall be bound by same. The execution of the
Recycling Agreement is hereby approved, ratified, and confirmed, and Briar Creek Borough
officials, as appropriate, are authorized to execute the Agreement.

RECYCLING AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 28th day of May, 2025, by and between BRIAR CREEK BOROUGH, a political subdivision organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (hereinafter "BRIAR CREEK") AND BERWICK BOROUGH, a political subdivision organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (hereinafter "BERWICK").

ACKNOWLEDGMENT

WHEREAS, BERWICK operates a Recycling Center for its residents located at the Test Track Park; and,

WHEREAS, BRIAR CREEK desires to have its residents be able to recycle at the Berwick Borough Drop-off Recycling Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exchange for the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. BRIAR CREEK residents shall be able to recycle plastic containers, steel and aluminum cans, glass bottles and jars, paper, cardboard, brush, and yard waste at the Berwick Borough Drop-off Recycling Center located at the Test Track Park.
2. BRIAR CREEK shall pay to BERWICK a sum equal to One Dollar (\$1.00) per resident, as determined by the latest census, which payment shall be made annually.
3. Either party may terminate this Agreement by providing sixty (60) days written notice to the other party. In the case of a termination of the Agreement, the annual payment, or refund, shall be pro-rated.


